Accompanying the digital transition of area studies (Middle East, Africa, Asia): the DISTAM consortium

After a brief introduction presenting the DISTAM consortium project, whose application for accreditation is currently being finalised, the round table will discuss the results of the optical recognition of manuscripts (HTR) pilot project on Maghrebi manuscripts from the BULAC collections, which was based on a hackaton organised in spring 2021. Two digital residency projects will then be presented: one on the digital approach to French iconographic representations of the abolition of slavery (IMAf) and the other on the integration of digital archives on the Syrian revolution as part of the preparation of the Lexique vivant de la révolution et de la guerre en Syrie (IREMAM).
